AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR A VEHICLE PURCHASE FROM CRAIN KIA OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ROGERS; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers has to periodically replace older vehicles used by city employees and city officials while conducting city business;

WHEREAS, Crain Kia of Bentonville, Arkansas, has offered the City a purchase price for a 2017 Toyota Prius that is within budget and that is comparable to the state contract pricing set by the state procurement office; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the purchase of twenty-four thousand, nine hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$24,999.00) was approved and budgeted in the City of Rogers 2019 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: There exists an exceptional circumstance whereby the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible and the City Council, therefore, waives the requirements of competitive bidding for purchase of a 2017 Toyota Prius from Crain Kia of Bentonville, Arkansas;

<u>Section 2 - Emergency Clause</u>: The need to acquire this vehicle is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 3 - Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 44-6(h) OF THE CITY OF ROGERS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CONCERNING THE GRANDFATHER CLAUSE FOR CERTAIN REGULATIONS RELATING TO NONCONFORMING, OBSOLETE, AND UNPERMITTED SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the language in the City of Rogers Code of Ordinances regarding the grandfather clause relating to nonconforming, obsolete, and unpermitted signs expired on December 31, 2018, before Arkansas Department of Transportation ("ARDOT") completed the highway project in the area regulated; and

WHEREAS, the grandfather clause needs to be extended to allow ARDOT to complete the project before the regulations go into effect in the affected area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 44-6(h), of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, Arkansas, is hereby amended and shall read as shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set out word for word herein. Any other subsections of Section 44-6 that are not shown in Exhibit "A" shall remain unchanged and continue to be in force as previously adopted;

<u>Section 2 - Emergency Clause</u>: That the need to amend said code is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect form the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 3 - Severability Provision</u>: In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable, or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein; and

<u>Section 4 - Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions</u>: All ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City Council, or parts of ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

EXHIBIT "A"

Sec. 44-6. - General regulations.

- (h) Nonconforming, obsolete, and unpermitted signs.
 - (1) Except as provided under subdivision (h)(2) of this section, signs which were lawful at the time of their construction or placement but are not in conformance with current regulations shall be permitted to be maintained as nonconforming signs until such time that the sign is replaced with new sign copy or with a change of use of the site. At that time, the sign shall be replaced with a sign compliant with these regulations.
 - (2) This exception in this subdivision (h)(2) of this section shall no longer apply after December 31, 2019. The owner of a multitenant sign that is located on the section of Walnut Street beginning at the east side of Dixieland Road and extending east to Eighth Street in the city of Rogers that would be required to restructure or rebuild their sign under this section may change individual tenant sign panels on the multitenant sign, if he or she first obtains a permit to do so. On and after January 1, 2020, any change of sign copy will require that the sign come into compliance with all aspects of this section.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

- <u>Section 1</u>: That the sum of eighty-two thousand seven hundred forty dollars (\$82,740.00) is hereby appropriated from Airport Fund Reserves into Account #315-15-81137 Capital Project 37;
- <u>Section 2</u>: That the Mayor and City Clerk may enter into a contract amendment with Garver, LLC, for design and bid phase services associated with the reconstruction of an aircraft taxiway and related improvements at the Rogers Executive Airport for an amount not to exceed sixty-two thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$62,550.00);
- <u>Section 3</u>: That the Mayor and City Clerk may enter into a contract amendment with Garver, LLC, for design and bid phase services associated with the reconstruction of an aircraft taxiway and related improvements at the Rogers Executive Airport for an amount not to exceed eleven thousand six hundred ninety dollars (\$11,690.00);
- <u>Section 4</u>: That the Mayor and City Clerk may enter into a contract with DBE Plans and Goals Preparation Services, for preparation of a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) plan and goals for the Rogers Executive Airport for an amount not to exceed eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00);
- <u>Section 5</u>: That the sum not to exceed seventy-four thousand two hundred forty dollars (\$74,240.00) shall be paid to Garver, LLC from Account #315-15-81137 Capital Project 37;
- <u>Section 6</u>: That the sum not to exceed eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) shall be paid to DBE Plans and Goals Preparation Services from Account #315-15-81137 Capital Project 37;

<u>Section 7</u>: That execution of said contract amendments with Garver, LLC shall be contingent upon the approval of the Federal Aviation Administration, as may be required.

<u>Section 8 - Severability Provision</u>: In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

ORDINANCE NO. _____ CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM R-DP TO NBT, PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES
