AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS OF CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS CONCERNING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; DECLARING ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR SECTION 2-468 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREFORE,** Arkansas Code § 19-11-801(c) authorizes the City to "elect to not use competitive bidding for other professional services" adopted by a 2/3 vote of the City Council;

**WHEREFORE,** certain municipal planning, urban design, and land regulation maps, documents, and codes are required by State law to be compiled and adopted, and it is essential that the City utilize consultants with specialized knowledge of the Northwest Arkansas, Rogers, our codes, and the sentiments and day-to-day lives of our citizens; and

**WHEREFORE**, the buildings that accommodate and house the varied services the City provides to the public require vastly different cleaning and janitorial needs, many of which can only be supplied by specialized providers skilled and certified in the areas to which they will be assigned.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> Code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, Arkansas § 2-468(b) is amended to add additional subsections to read as follows:

(b)(21) Consulting services for municipal planning, urban design, and land regulation; and

(b)(22) Janitorial and cleaning services.

<u>Section 2 – Emergency Clause</u>: The need to amend the City Code is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 3 - Severability Provision:</u> If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 4 - Repeal of Conflicting Provisions</u>: All ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

WHEREAS, the Final Plat has been submitted for Foxbriar Subdivision, Phase 2, Rogers, Benton County Arkansas which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM A-1 to R-O , PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Rogers Code Section Rogers Code Section 14-725, et seq, and upon the consideration of the report and recommendations of the Planning Commission of the City of Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, the City Council has found that certain lands hereinafter described are better suited for R-O zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Rogers Code Section 14-675 should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as R-O and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

Lots 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, and 8 Glen Vista Addition, Rogers, Arkansas.

**LAYMAN'S DESCRIPTION:** Part of the NE Corner of Arapaho and New Hope.

SECTION 3: **Zoning.** That the above described lands are better suited for R-O than A-1 zoning and same should be and are hereby zoned R-O.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> **Emergency clause.** That because the City is herein zoning property which is subject to a present use and said use should be brought into conformity with the zoning laws of the City of Rogers, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> **Severability Provision.** In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

<u>SECTION 5:</u> **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
