**WHEREAS,** it is the Rogers City Council's intent that the Rogers Police Department Standard Operating Guidelines be set forth in a clear and concise manner to assure compliance with the City of Rogers Code of Ordinances as well as with State and Federal requirements;

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Standard Operating Guidelines for the Rogers Police Department as set forth as Exhibit A are adopted.

<u>Section 2 - Severability Provision:</u> If any of the Resolution is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 3 - Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions</u>: All resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
