A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET; RECOGNIZING FUNDS FROM THE ROGERS SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF ROGERS FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FOURTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$14,651.00) INTO ACCOUNT #100-04-49255 REIMBURSEMENTS; APPROPRIATING THAT SAME AMOUNT TO VARIOUS EXPENSE ACCOUNTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed a Resolution approving an Informal Agreement with the Rogers School District allowing off-duty paramedics of the Rogers Fire Department to serve as substitute nurses within the school;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Informal Agreement, costs for employment services shall be reimbursed by the Rogers School District.

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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COX ADVANCED SERVICES ARKANSAS, LLC, OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$143,481.58), FOR UNDERGROUND UTILITY INSTALLATION AND TO PROVIDE POWER NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY RELATED TO THE WALNUT WIDENING PROJECT; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development, working with Cox Advanced Services Arkansas, has determined that the installation of underground utilities for the Walnut Widening Project is necessary for the public safety of the citizens of Rogers;

WHEREAS, this installation is not for the direct benefit of particular customers of the utility in their capacity as customers; and

WHEREAS, Cox Advanced Services Arkansas is the appropriate company to provide this service as they own all necessary equipment to perform this work and are familiar with the area and work involved; therefore, competitive bidding should be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cox Advanced Services Arkansas, LLC, of Springdale, Arkansas, for utility installation along the Walnut Widening project, in an amount not to exceed one hundred forty-three thousand four hundred eighty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$143,481.58);

Section 2: This amount shall be paid from 2018 Street Bonds;

<u>Section 3:</u> The requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible and the City Council waives the requirements of competitive bidding;

<u>Section 4: Emergency Clause:</u> The need to enter into said contract is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 5: Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 6: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions</u>: All ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
