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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A JOINT PROCUREMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE ROGERS WATER UTILITIES FOR THE PURCHASE OF CITYWORKS SOFTWARE LICENSES; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE SOFTWARE LICENSES; AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$40,000) FROM GENERAL FUND RESERVES INTO ACCOUNT #100-09-70256 SOFTWARE LICENSING; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase licenses for certain municipal and utility management software known as Cityworks;

WHEREAS, a Cityworks software license is acquired from Azteca Systems, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company;

WHEREAS, soliciting bids for Cityworks would not produce competitive bids as Azteca Systems, LLC is the sole provider of the desired software that is being requested by Rogers Waterworks Utilities ("RWU") and the City;

WHEREAS, an exceptional situation exists such that seeking the required software through competitive bidding is not feasible or practical;

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to purchase Cityworks licenses as part of a joint procurement with the RWU. Both RWU and the City will equally share in the cost to purchase the software licenses and will also be proportionally sharing the cost of the associated software integration and implementation services;

WHEREAS, the Rogers Waterworks and Sewer Commission has passed its Resolution No. 20-14, waiving the requirements of competitive bidding for purchase of the Cityworks licenses and authorizing RWU to enter into a Joint Procurement Agreement with the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff and RWU have negotiated the terms of a Joint Procurement Agreement for Purchase of Cityworks Software Licenses and Implementation Services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a Joint Procurement Agreement with RWU for Purchase of Cityworks Software Licenses and Implementation Services.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a Cityworks License and Maintenance Agreement with Azteca Systems, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, on behalf of the City and RWU, subject to the terms of the Joint Procurement Agreement with RWU. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to approve the final form and content of the Cityworks License and Maintenance Agreement, their approval to be indicated by their signature thereon.

<u>Section 3:</u> The 2020 Budget is hereby amended to appropriate forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) from General Fund Reserves into Account #100-09-70256 Software Licensing.

<u>Section 4</u>: This appropriation will be used to pay the City's share of the first year of the cost of the license agreement for Cityworks Software as part of the joint procurement with RWU.

<u>Section 5</u>: There exists an exceptional circumstance whereby the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible and the City Council, therefore, waives the requirements of competitive bidding for purchase of the Cityworks software licenses.

<u>Section 6 - Emergency Clause</u>: The need to acquire the Cityworks software and the associated software integration and implementation services is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after the date of its passage.

<u>Section 7 - Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed.

<u>Section 8 - Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances</u>: All Ordinances of the City Council, or parts of Ordinances of the City Council, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM R-DP TO NBT, PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Rogers Code Section Rogers Code Section 14-725, et seq, and upon the consideration of the report and recommendations of the Planning Commission of the City of Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, on June 16, 2020, the City Council has found that certain lands hereinafter described are better suited for NBT zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That Section 14-675 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as NBT and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

- <u>SECTION 3</u>: **Zoning**. That the above described lands are better suited for NBT than R-DP zoning and same should be and are hereby zoned NBT.
- SECTION 4: Emergency Clause. That it is necessary to bring proposed uses of the property into conformance with the Rogers City Zoning Ordinances and because of such an emergency is declared to exist and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM N-R TO NBT, PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Rogers Code Section Rogers Code Section 14-725, et seq, and upon the consideration of the report and recommendations of the Planning Commission of the City of Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, on June 16, 2020, the City Council has found that certain lands hereinafter described are better suited for NBT zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **ROGERS, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1: That Section 14-675 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as NBT and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

- SECTION 3: **Zoning**. That the above described lands are better suited for NBT than N-R zoning and same should be and are hereby zoned NBT.
- SECTION 4: Emergency Clause. That it is necessary to bring proposed uses of the property into conformance with the Rogers City Zoning Ordinances and because of such an emergency is declared to exist and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.
- Severability Provision. In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO TWO CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WITH GARVER, LLC, OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS TO AMEND THE MASTER ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$295,600.00) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE TAXILANE/RECONSTRUCT TAXIWAY PROJECT AT THE ROGERS EXECUTIVE AIRPORT; AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$295,600.00) FROM AIRPORT FUND RESERVES INTO ACCOUNT NUMBER #315-15-81138 CONSTRUCT TAXIWAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Rogers Executive Airport anticipates the receipt of a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration to reconstruct an existing aircraft taxiway and construct an aircraft taxilane at the Rogers Executive Airport;

WHEREAS, the Rogers Executive Airport has received a grant from the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics for various elements of the project;

WHEREAS, Garver, LLC is the engineer of record for the design and construction phase services for this project;

WHEREAS, the Rogers Airport Commission has reviewed the construction phase services contract amendments and recommended approval by unanimous vote;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a contract amendment with Garver, LLC, for Construction Phase Services associated with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) AIP 38 Construct Taxilane/Reconstruct Taxiway project in an amount not to exceed two hundred eight-two thousand dollars (\$282,000.00);

- <u>Section 2:</u> The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a contract amendment with Garver, LLC, for Construction Phase Services for the related Arkansas Department of Aeronautics funded elements of the Construct Taxilane/Reconstruct Taxiway project in an amount not to exceed thirteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$13,600.00);
- <u>Section 3:</u> The execution of said contract amendments is subject to the receipt of FAA grant funding for the referenced project, with the awarded schedule predicated on the amount of funding received, and further subject to FAA review and approval;

<u>Section 4:</u> The 2020 Budget is amended to appropriate the sum of two hundred ninety-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$295,600.00) from Airport Fund into Account #315-15-81138 Construct Taxiway;

<u>Section 5: Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Resolution is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 6: Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions</u>: All resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of resolutions or orders of the City Council, in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
