AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NABHOLZ CONSTRUCTION OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, FOR EMERGENCY DRAINAGE REPAIR WORK IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$94,955.00); APPROPRIATING NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$94,955.00) FROM STREET FUND RESERVES INTO ACCOUNT #200-16-70935 DRAINAGE CONSTRUCTION; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the subdivision Champions Estate, and its surrounding area, have experienced flooding due to storm-water runoff and new drainage pipes and other associated work is needed to divert the water away from this area;

WHEREAS, Nabholz Construction of Conway, Arkansas, has substantial experience in this type of drainage repair work and is available to perform the repairs immediately;

WHEREAS, due to the emergency nature of the repair work needed, it is not feasible to bid the type of repairs needed without the subdivision, and its surrounding area, suffering damages; therefore, competitive bidding should be waived so the drainage pipe and associated work can be completed quickly as time is of the essence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Mayor and City Clerk may enter into a contract with Nabholz Construction of Conway, Arkansas, in the amount of ninety-four thousand nine hundred fifty five dollars (\$94,955.00) for emergency drainage repair work;

Section 2: The 2020 Budget is amended to appropriate ninety-four thousand nine hundred fifty five dollars (\$94,955.00) from Street Fund Reserves into Account #200-16-70935 Drainage Construction;

Section 3: There exists an exceptional circumstance whereby the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible and the City Council, therefore, waives the requirements of competitive bidding for the drainage repair work;

<u>Section 4: Emergency Clause</u>: The need to make the drainage repairs is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

Section 5: Severability Provision: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 6: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions: All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That Section 14-675 of the code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as U-NBT and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

<u>SECTION 5</u>: **Emergency Clause.** That because the City is herein zoning property which is subject to a present use and said use should be brought into conformity with the zoning laws of the City of Rogers, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

<u>SECTION 6:</u> Severability Provision. In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid

or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

<u>SECTION 7:</u> **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
