ORDINANCE NO. 18-____

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY AND ANY INTEREST IN ANY REAL PROPERTY TO FACILITATE STREET IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER PROJECTS PURSUANT TO THE 2018 CITY OF ROGERS BOND ISSUE; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City of Rogers Mayor and Community Development, Streets, Parks, Police, Fire, and Legal Departments, and any authorized agents thereof, are hereby authorized to take all necessary legal action in obtaining interests in real property in order to facilitate land acquisition for the purposes described in the 2018 Capital Improvement Bond Issue passed by the citizens of the City of Rogers;

<u>Section 2</u>: This authority shall include, but not be limited to purchasing, negotiation, bargaining, trading, and, if necessary, the institution of Eminent Domain Causes of Action necessary to accomplish improvements authorized by said Bond Issue;

<u>Section 3 - Emergency Clause</u>: The need to acquire necessary property is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 4 - Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 5 - Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions</u>: All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ATMS TRAFFICWARE SYSTEM FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ROGERS STREET DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers Street Department is in need of an ATMS Trafficware System for traffic control maintenance and has obtained an offer to purchase the system;

WHEREAS, Trafficware Engineered by Naztec is the only company that provides this device, that meets the technical advances for the future and ties into the City's current system; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the purchase of two hundred eighty-six thousand four hundred nineteen dollars and seventy cents (\$286,419.70) was approved and budgeted in the City of Rogers 2018 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: There exists an exceptional circumstance whereby the requirements of competitive bidding are neither practical nor feasible and the City Council, therefore, waives the requirements of competitive bidding for the purchase of an ATMS Trafficware System for use by the City of Rogers Street Department;

<u>Section 2: Emergency Clause</u> - The need to acquire quality City of Rogers Street Department is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval;

<u>Section 3: Severability Provision</u> - If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions</u> - All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ROBERT L. BROWN REVOCABLE TRUST FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY; AMENDING THE 2018 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING THREE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED AND FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,405,000.00) FROM STREET FUND RESERVES TO ACCOUNT # 200-16-80100 CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers Street Department needs to relocate facilities and this purchase will facilitate the relocation;

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers acknowledges that the current compensation estimate shows the value for this property is four million four hundred sixty eight thousand dollars (\$4,468, 000.000); and

WHEREAS, this property value is significantly greater than the agreed upon price and the City of Rogers recognizes the contribution by the Robert L. Brown Revocable Trust in their support of the Street Department facility relocation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to purchase, pursuant to Ark. Code. Ann. § 14-54-302, and in accordance with the procedures set forth in said statutes, real property which is needed to serve the needs of the City for a public or governmental purpose, described as follows:

Parcel No. 02-00786-000 Also Known As: 1203 North 6th Street City of Rogers, Arkansas, Benton County

<u>Section 2</u>: Amending the 2018 Budget by appropriating three million four hundred and five thousand dollars (\$3,405,000.00) from Street Fund Reserves to Account # 200-16-80100 Capital Expenditures.

<u>Section 3: Severability Provision</u> - In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE USE AND OCCUPATION OF PUBLIC EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City has been requested by non-regulated broadband network providers to provide for use of the public easements and rights-of-way to construct and maintain fiber optic networks; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Rogers to enter into agreements to provide for the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and to help facilitate growth and development.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into agreements for the use of public easements and rights-of-way. The agreements shall be in a form to be approved by the Mayor and City Clerk, their approval is to be evidenced by their signatures;

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #17-82; PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017 the Rogers City Council passed Ordinance No. 17-82, prohibiting a person from approaching an occupied vehicle if the vehicle is in operation and on a public street;

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Dilbeck et. al. v. Clark, et. al.*, the Ordinance has been found to be an unconstitutional restriction of First and Fourteenth Amendment rights; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers has found it necessary to repeal said Ordinance to uphold the constitutional rights of its citizens, tourists, and visitors.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City of Rogers has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to repeal the Ordinance establishing the prohibition of approaching an occupied vehicle on a public street. Therefore, ORD #17-82 is hereby repealed;

<u>Section 2: Emergency Clause</u> - That the need to repeal said Ordinance is urgent, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective on its date of passage and publication;

<u>Section 3: Severability Provision</u> - In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein; and

<u>Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions</u> - All Ordinances, Resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council appreciate the hard work and dedication of each employee of the City of Rogers as this commitment has contributed greatly to the continued economic and social advancement of the City and its citizens; and

<u>Section 1</u>: The Mayor may make a one-time gross payment of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to each city employee who was employed with the City of Rogers on November 18, 2018;

<u>Section 2</u>: One hundred eighty two thousand, two hundred eighty four dollars (\$184,284) is appropriated from General Reserves, Street Reserves, and Airport Fund Reserves to the following accounts in the following amounts to make the payments authorized by this Resolution:

General Fund Reserves in the amount of \$170,847.00 to Salaries and Wages, FICA Expense, Retirement APERS, and Retirement LOPFI;

Street Fund Reserves in the amount of \$9,961.00 to Salaries and Wages, FICA Expense, and Retirement APERS; and

Airport Fund Reserves in the amount of \$1,476.00 to Salaries and Wages, FICA Expense, and Retirement APERS;

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD FOR EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE FOR 2019; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers provides health insurance coverage to city employees and will do so in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers City Council has previously waived competitive bidding for the contract with Blue Cross Blue Shield to provide that health insurance coverage, because Blue Cross Blue Shield has a quality professional reputation, provides a low cost to employees, has technological advantages over its competitor, and there is a limited field of competitors from which to choose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Mayor may enter into a contract with Blue Cross Blue Shield for employee health insurance for the 2019 calendar year.

<u>SECTION 7:</u> **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

ORDINANCE NO. _____ CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM A-1 TO C-3, PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Rogers Code Section Rogers Code Section 14-725, et seq, and upon the consideration of the report and recommendations of the Planning Commission of the City of Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, the City Council has found that certain lands hereinafter described are better suited for C-3 than A-1 zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 14-675 of the code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as A-1 and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

Part of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 30 West, Benton County, Arkansas, and being more particularly described as: Commencing at the SW corner of the SW 1/4 of said Section 8, thence along the West line of said SW 1/4, N 00°31'05'' W 827.61 feet; thence leaving said West line, N 89°40'53'' E 30.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence N 00°31'05'' W 501.87 feet; thence N 89°40'53'' E 1157.61 feet; thence S 00°49'34'' E 501.88 feet; thence S 89°40'53'' W 1161.31 feet to the point of beginning, containing 581,636.80 square feet or 13.35 acres, more or less, and subject to all rights of way, easements and restrictive covenants of record or fact.
