- ◆ Each “Patrol” begins with a basic safety inspection of the ABCs of bicycle maintenance—Air, Breaks, Chain.
- ◆ Proper safety equipment must be worn.
- ◆ Bring plenty of water.
- ◆ Children under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- ◆ Saturday rides begin at 8am at the Rogers High School trail head.
- ◆ Sunday rides begin at 8am at the Cambridge Park trailhead.
- ◆ Locations and start times may vary.

enforcement in a relaxed, open air environment. The bike -long offers citizens an opportunity to speak with officers about any community issues and build relationships while enjoying the great outdoors.

There will be two “patrols” each weekend: a “long” ride on Saturday of around 12 miles, and a “short” ride of about 7.5 miles on Sunday.
