Re: Rogers District Court Rescheduling

To whom it may concern,

Due to the Arkansas Supreme Court's issuance of the Per Curiam Order delivered April 23, 2020, and the lack of clarity regarding what restrictions might be imposed on us during the "re-opening" process, I have recently signed an Order resetting any "in person" court appearances until after May 31st, 2020.

All Pro Se litigants will receive written notice of their new court dates and all represented parties will have notice sent to their attorney(s) in accordance with the terms of this court's Order.

Both City and County Prosecutors are still working and available for defense counsel to contact and attempt to resolve cases via written plea agreements. <u>It is highly encouraged for defense counsel</u> to resolve as many cases as possible through written plea agreement without necessitating a court appearance regardless of how far out the case may be set.

The Defendants will still be given the standard <u>14 days to appear to arrange their payments</u> <u>and public service</u>. The front windows of the court are still open and being staffed by the court clerks. Due to the fact that many of our public service work locations are not accepting workers at this time, the Defendants will be given a minimum of 90 days to comply with public service work requirements. Further, fines will not be set for a first payment until 90 days after their initial appearance <u>at the front</u> <u>window</u>.

The court will be monitoring the situation with the public service work providers and will be accommodating in granting extensions to resolve the required PSW, and fine extensions, for those that have exercised the initiative and resolved their cases without an appearance.

The court windows are still open Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm so that defendants and litigants can come in and sign for extensions, continuances, and to file any motions.

RESCHEDULING ORDER

- 20.All of the "Speedy Trial" time lost due to the above continuances shall be excluded from the time the State/City shall have to prosecute the affected cases per A.R.C.P. 28.3(h).
- 21. The Criminal and Civil Clerk "windows" shall remain open in the Courthouse during the pendency of this Order to allow the Court to accept payments, create continuances, allow public service to be turned in, and to otherwise deal with the day to day administration of the Court's functions.
- 22.All Defense Counsel, including the Public Defender, are encouraged to contact the Prosecuting Attorney's Office as they are still working and available for defense counsel to resolve cases via written plea agreements.
- 23. Per the Arkansas Supreme Court Per Curiam Order delivered April 23, 2020, if any party has a pending legal issue that requires the party to appear in person, please contact the District Court Clerk immediately to discuss the situation and determine what accommodations can be made.
