Policy Title: Apparatus Replacement Schedule

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PURPOSE

To ensure that vehicles serving the community are reliable and provide for the safety of personnel this policy will outline the RFD's apparatus replacement guidelines as recommended in NFPA 1901, Standard for Automotive Fire Apparatus.

POLICY

Each year the Department shall assess the apparatus. This policy provides estimates on service life in both the front line and reserve capacities without taking into consideration the specific attributes of apparatus, which can include frequency of use, maintenance cost, mileage, engine hours and years of service. However, to ensure the safest and most efficient use resources from the City of Rogers, the following apparatus replacement guidelines shall be practiced:
