

2015 ROGERS FIRE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL RISK REDUCTION PLAN

The 2015 Rogers Fire Department Annual Risk Reduction Plan (ARRP) serves to inform personnel of the prevention activities during the 2015 calendar year. The ARRP is directed at all divisions, areas printed in red will directly effects all divisions. The ARRP was developed in conjunction with the 2015 Rogers Fire Department Annual Training Plan (ATP) and the Annual Field Operations Plan (AFOP). The ARRP will systematically address prevention needs in the form of building inspections, hydrant inspections, and community education.

Through policies and the ARRP, assurance will be made that programs are ingrained into the Department as the way we do business. As a result, the Department will mitigate risk-related events prior to their occurrence providing for a safer community to live, work, and visit. In 2015, the following four areas will receive a greater focus:

- 1. Inspecting 100% of medium and high risk occupancies
- 2. Delivering seasonal public service announcements (PSAs)
- 3. Delivering exceptional core prevention programs
 - a. K-5 Fire Prevention Education
 - b. Junior Fire Marshal's Program
- 4. Sprinkler Demo with HBA
- 5. Moving forward with plans to construct a safety village through grant and private funds.

Every attempt will be made to adhere with the ARRP as the year progresses. However, the ARRP compliments the ATP, and therefore must be fluid and flexible. The ARRP is subject to change at the discretion of Department leadership.
