## **General Facility Rules**

- 1. All persons entering the aquatic center, including supervising adults, must pay the appropriate fees.
- 2. Proper swim attire is required at all times. No cut-offs or suits deemed inappropriate by management. No clothing with suggestive or profane images, or words. Swimwear with zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation will not be allowed on slides.
- 3. Disposable or cloth diapers are prohibited in pools. Swim diapers will be available for purchase at the admissions office.
- 4. Smoking or use of tobacco will not be permitted inside the aquatics center or on city park property.

- 5. No gum will be allowed inside the gates of the aquatic center.
- 6. For your safety, no running or rough horseplay will be tolerated.
- 7. Guests should not play or loiter on water entries stairs/ramps and or entries such as park and bathroom entries.
- 8. People under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted.
- 9. Coolers, food or drinks may not be brought into the park. Glass containers of any kind will not be permitted.
- 10. Containers such as stainless steel tumblers and re-fillable plastic sports bottles are permitted.
- 11. Flotation devices must be coast guard approved. No inflatables. Water toys are subject to the approval of management.
- 12. A parent or chaperone 16 years or older must supervise children 7 years and under in the water at all times. 1 in-water chaperone is required for every 5 swimmers 7 years of age and under.
- 13. Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by a chaperone 16 years/over.
- 14. Pavilions are first-come, first-serve unless rented.
- 15. Guests may exit and re-enter the park. A hand stamp will be necessary to re-enter.
