BENTON COUNTY HOUSEHOLDS may dispose of allowed specified materials **AT NO CHARGE DURING 2016 PILOT PROGRAM**. Materials generated by a non-household will NOT be accepted. Suspected non-household material will be rejected.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Household Hazardous Waste – Subject to compliance with program rules below and acceptable material and volume limits. Refer to the very strict limitations of material types and allowed volumes on the back of flyer .

- ✓
- ✓ **Household Electronics** such as radios, DVDs, VCRs, telephones, televisions, computers, monitors, printers, microwaves, etc.
- ✓ **Household Furniture** such as mattresses, couches, tables, chairs, etc.
- ✓ **Household Appliances** such as refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners, dehumidifiers, icemakers, water heaters, ranges, washers, dryers, etc. **PLEASE NOTE: ALL FOOD PRODUCTS MUST BE REMOVED FROM REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS BEFORE DELIVERY TO THE SATELLITE CENTER.**
- ✓ **Large Yard Toys** such as large plastic toys, playground eqmt., swing sets, etc..
- ✓ **Scrap Metal** such as grills, bicycles, metal fencing, metal lawn furniture, etc.
- ✓ **Up to four (4) passenger tires without rims** per household **per month**. Additional tires, tires on rims and larger tires WILL NOT be accepted at satellite locations.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

ONLY the items specified above which were generated by a household will be accepted through the Convenience Center. All other items will be unacceptable including but not limited to:

- ✗ Household trash or garbage
- ✗ Commercial, industrial or business waste
- ✗ Construction/demolition debris and yard, windows, doors, etc.

Household Hazardous Waste at the Convenience Center Satellites.

- **CONTAINERS CANNOT BE RETURNED AT THE SATELLITES! PLEASE BRING DISPOSABLE CONTAINERS ONLY.**
- **PLEASE HAVE MATERIAL AVAILABLE** where our staff can easily remove it from the vehicle.
- ♦ **USE CAUTION WHEN TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.** Place items inside a plastic tub to prevent spilling in your vehicle. Place leaking containers inside separate bins or buckets to prevent dangerous interaction with other materials.
- ♦ **DO NOT BRING EMPTY CONTAINERS!** Rinse containers according to package labels and recycle or dispose.
- ♦ **LATEX PAINT IS NOT HAZARDOUS.** If the paint in the can is less than 1/2 gallon, dry it by mixing with kitty litter or sawdust and then place open cans in your regular trash.
- ♦ **DO NOT MIX THE CONTENTS** of different containers or unknown materials together.
- ♦ **COMMERCIALLY GENERATED MATERIAL CANNOT BE ACCEPTED** at the Household Hazardous Waste facility! All non-household material (from business, school, farm, churches, etc.) **MUST** be handled by a commercial hazardous waste company. Contact our office for a list of companies that operate in our area.

Aerosols	12 cans
Anti-freeze	Up to 5 gallons
Ballasts (PCB)	Up to 2 ballasts
Ballasts (non PCB)	No Limit (must say "Non-PCB")
Batteries (alkaline)	2 lbs or 1/2 gallon size container
Batteries (lithium)	No Limit
Batteries (NiCad)	No Limit
Bulbs (Compact Fluor./CFL)	20 bulbs
Bulbs (Fluorescent Tubes)	8 bulbs (any length)
Bulbs (High Intensity/HID)	2 each
Bulbs (shattershield)	2 each
Cleaners (water based)	Up to (5) 32 oz bottles
Cooking Oil	Up to 5 gallons
Corrosive liquids	Up to 1 gallon
Cylinders compressed gas	Up to 5 cylinders or extinguishers
Fertilizers	Up to 20 lbs solid or 1 gallon liquid
Flammable liquids	Up to 2 gallons
Flammable solids	Up to 2 pounds
Misc. Pool Chemicals	Up to 1 pound solid or 1 quart liquid
Oil - motor, gear, lub	Up to 5 gallons
Oil filters	Up to 4 filters
Paint latex	Up to 5 gallons total
Paint lead based	Up to 1 gallon total
Paint oil based	Up to 5 gallons total
Pesticides - liquid	Up to 1 gallon
Pesticides - solid	Up to 5 pounds
Sharps	Up to 1 gallon size container
Tar & Sealers	Up to 5 gallons total
