PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure all local amendments are recognized and enforced.

POLICY

It shall be the responsibility of building inspectors / plans examiners to familiarize themselves with all local amendments. While conducting inspections or plan examinations, the most stringent shall be enforced if a conflict in the locally adopted amendments and the Arkansas Fire Prevention Code exists.

Building inspector / plans examiners shall take a written examination annually on local amendments to ensure compliance. The minimum passing score shall be no less than eighty percent (80%). If a score of less than eighty percent (80%) is achieved, the building inspector / plans examiner shall be placed in remedial training until which time they can pass the written examination.
